He opened his first dealership from a rented space in Nunawading. Two years later he set up a dealership on Springvale Road 200 metres up from the current site.

Garry continues to be very actively involved in the business together with his son, Barry. With the motorsport business now taking far more of Garry's time, Barry's management of the car dealership has assisted it to grow from strength to strength.

Garry began his motorsport career in the early 1960's. After retiring from race driving in the late nineties he established Garry Rogers Motorsport which has enjoyed considerable success in more than ten categories of Australian motorsport.
